## THE CHARACTERS

## THE S CENE

A high school library. MARCY and ALEX sit at a table: The LIBRARIAN sits off to one side at a desk.

## **ACT ONE**

MARCY wearing The Cranberries t-shirt flips through an ACLU magazine. ALEX looks around the library, casually observing people. TABBIE and NATALIE enter and rush up to their table.

**LIBRARIAN** 

No running in the library, please.

**TABBIE** 

We weren't running.

LIBRARIAN glares at TABBIE and NATALIE sternly.

**TABBIE** 

Fine. Sorry.

**NATALIE** 

Sorry.

**LIBRARIAN** 

And do be courteous to others and (signals the Shhh sign.)

TABBIE starts to respond but the LIBRARIAN reinforces the Shhh sign. TABBIE nods. NATALIE nods with Shhh sign back at the Librarian. The girls sit.

**ALEX** 

Hey, Tabs. Nat.

**NATALIE** 

Hey.

**TABBIE** 

Hey, Alex. Marcy.

MARCY glances up to respond and just as quickly resumes leafing her magazine.

**MARCY** 

Tabbie. Natalie.

**TABBIE** 

Oh my god. You guys are not going to believe what's going on.

**NATALIE** 

It's so messed up.

MARCY

Oh my god. Right?! Are you referring to the impending fall of democracy, rise of fascism, systemic racism, criminalization of bodily autonomy and self-identity, banning of books, global warming, world hunger, or ...

NATALIE looks at MARCY like she's crazy.

**NATALIE** 

No.

MARCY

(ignoring Natalie)

It feels like I'm forgetting some things.

**NATALIE** 

Really?

**TABBIE** 

Um - while all that's truly terrifying and causes me serious anxiety now that you've brought it up-

I agree. It is anxiety producing. Precisely why we must care.

**TABBIE**
